Hi there.
Thanks for sending the email below. Unsure where it went when you sent it! I am glad to have it so I can help.
I would like to clarify that an email was sent on 6/23 to this email address regarding the committee work. I wanted to be sure you were aware of that.

I will be in touch with complainants as it relates to your questions below about the hearing. As you know, the committee is just beginning their work and has not established all of the details you have asked about. When we do, it will be communicated with those who wish to be involved in the hearing. Certainly we will work to give ample time for scheduling and preparation for those who wish to participate. Our goal—as I am sure it is yours—is to have helpful dialogue regarding the experience of student’s in our schools. We will work to create a schedule and structure that offers that for all parties.

Regarding the point of clarification, I am the chair of the committee and you are welcome to email questions and I will answer them. **Re: My request for Reconsideration of Instructional Materials and Textbooks by email to Gish of 6/2/2021 and as amended or supplemented
Gish email to me of June 11, 2021, advising of 4.403 committee to be formed by 6/22**

I have received no further information since Gish’s email of 6/11/2021 such that my ability to support my complaint and participate adequately in the hearing will be impaired. Accordingly, I ask that you advise me directly and timely of the status of the Committee and all material information as to the format and operational rules of the hearing required by 4.403 7,c to include

- Notice requirements
- Time, date and location
- Agenda
- Names, titles, roles and authorities of all participants or other parties at interest in the hearing
- Standing of each participant
- Limitations of rights of complainants to participate in the hearing, if any

- Limitations of rights of complainants to be represented by counsel, jointly or severally, if any
- Your assurance of adequate & timely advance notice to me & other complainants to allow adequate time to prepare
- Your assurance that members of the Committee are obligated to speak truthfully without omission of any material fact or circumstance which omission would cause a statement to be untrue or misleading

Lastly, WCS finally posted a list of the texts & materials of the curriculum on its web site (wcs.edu/domain/1416) on or about 7/29/ 2021. That is almost two months subsequent to the filing of my request for review. Has the Committee or other made the entire curriculum, including textbooks, teachers' notes, and other related programmatic material, fully available to complainants and the public?
