Ahron,

Thanks for contacting us.

Based on what you emailed Ms. Garrett, it sounds like you may be working with a student-led club. We believe student-led clubs are an important opportunity for them. For about 40 years, we have given students opportunities to lead student-led clubs through the student equal access laws. The core of this is that students lead without school involvement other than monitoring and ensuring student safety and adherence to school rules. This structure protects religious-based clubs and any other topical from government interference. I think it's a good system. We are very intentional about respecting the student equal access laws through these clubs. As part of that, we make sure that we don't promote one group or one idea above another but truly give them equal access regardless of content. If this is the case with you, I encourage you to work with those student leaders to lead whatever effort you are considering for your organization. This method would serve the true purpose of a student-led club by continuing to build the capacity of the students you are working with.

If your organization has other thoughts and a mission that you believe shouldn't include the FHS students you are working with, I would be happy to meet with you and hear what you would like to share with us. I am cc'ing my assistant Lydia Glynn as a resource for you to schedule time with me.
